In poetic prose, the child muses on the moon, likening themselves and their journey to the celestial body. Deep blues of a star-speckled sky contrast with the golden arcs of the desert landscape; most pages are split in half by this dichotomy. Bold hope is the theme of this picture book, available in both English and Spanish.
