The brief completion time makes these projects perfect for those looking to fashion quick but beautiful hand-made gifts. The author, a fabric designer and interiors expert who contributes to *Crafts Beautiful* magazine and appears on BBC Television, presents designs for looks from classic to contemporary. She recommends, for example, combining solid-color fabrics with bold prints to help prevent the pattern from overpowering the style, and using curved shapes such as hearts and circles with square grids for an eye-pleasing contrast.
