When she tries to make a list of goals she wants to achieve before she dies Rachelle realizes she doesnt have any hopes that arent her husbands or childrens. She needs a break from her ambitious self-centered husband and ends up in her old college town. She is repeatedly thrown into the path of her ex-husband Troy and she comes to realize that maybe it isnt coincidence that has brought them both back to Jubilant Texas.
